The Denton Town Elections were held on Tuesday, Nov. 6, 2018. Voting began promptly at 7:00 AM and was held until 8:00 PM. This year residents voted to fill one position on the Town Council.

Candidates:

- *Abigail McNinch – received 176 votes and was elected to serve a 5 - year term***
- *13 Write ins*

****Abigail McNinch was re-elected into office and will be sworn in and begin serving a 5-year term at the first Council meeting in January 2019.** In January, the Council will also appoint one of its members to serve as the Mayor for 2019.
