Beauty Salons & Barber Shops	Open – Modified Operations	Not to exceed 50% of max occupancy* To provide hair services only as defined by State law Face coverings required for staff & customers over age 2 Service by appointment only Cleaning and disinfection required after each customer Must comply with physical distancing guidance from CDC & State Health Dept.
